Camp Raintree's staff consist of Camp Counselors, Workshop Instructors, Activity Room Staff, and Lifeguards.

Brief Job Descriptions:

Camp Counselors - are staff who manage a group of campers throughout the day, leading them through the various activities and assisting the Workshop Instructors in their set activity for the hour. At each new activity, Counselors are required to balance supervision of the campers with involvement in the activity itself which in turn engages the students in said activity.

Workshop Instructors - are staff who are stationed in either a particular room or outside and who create the curriculum for that workshop for the summer. Workshops include but are not limited to drama, art, outside time, and odds and ends. We are open to new suggestions!

Activity Room Staff - are staff who are stationed in particular rooms which do not require much prior planning. Most all materials/equipment needed are in Raintree's possession. Activity Rooms include but are not limited to small game (board and card games), techno, big games, and construction.

Lifeguards - Staff stationed at the pool specifically for supervising the lap pool, diving well and pool deck. These staff have active/current lifeguard certification.
